Bare Lake Information	
Location:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 400km North East of Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada • 51°11' N, 120° 32'W • Located within Bonaparte Provincial Park • Bare Lake Lodge is the only facility on the lake, offering complete solitude • 4650 ft elevation (1414 m)
Getting There:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Flights into Vancouver Intl Airport (YVR) from all major airports • Shuttle service to Kamloops Airport (YKA) (~3.5 hours) • Option #1: Helicopter flight to Bare Lake Dock (<30 minutes) • Option #2: 1.5 hour drive up forest service road + 30 minute walk in
Fishing:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lakes are regularly stocked with Kamloops Rainbow Trout • 7 lakes are accessible from Bare Lake Lodge • Fish size averages 1.5lbs. Fish up to 5 lbs are catchable • Boats provided – 12ft boats w/ swivel cushion seats – 2.5hp motors
Lodging:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can handle groups from 8 – 16 guests • Groups have the camp and lake completely to themselves • 5 separate cabins w/ capacity of 2 to 5 guests each in single beds • Daily linen service • Wood stoves for heat
Main Lodge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fully equipped kitchen • BBQ area with large BBQs and flat grill • Dining area • Comfortable sitting room for enjoying cocktails or relaxing with a book • Library and games
Amenities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camp is powered by solar/battery/generator hybrid energy system • Wood fired hot tub • Horseshoe pit • Heated shower house with two heat on demand shower rooms • Fish smoker
Season	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camp is open from June through end of September
